

13th Gynaecological & Early Pregnancy Ultrasound Workshop

Who is the course for?

Following the Basic Ultrasound Workshops we have been conducting since 2010, the 13th gynaecological ultrasound workshop is an advanced postgraduate skills training programme targeted at experienced sonographers, General Practitioners, trainees, Consultants and doctors who use gynaecological ultrasound in their clinical work.

Objectives

To gain an understanding of ultrasound physics, technology and advanced skills to perform and interpret the images with emphasis on common gynaecological conditions including ovarian masses, endometriosis and first trimester pregnancy failures. Topics include sonographic approach to IOTA Rules, Deep Infiltrating Endometriosis and recent advances in the ultrasound evaluation of Caesarean scars. Practical guidelines in the diagnosis of pregnancy failure, classification of miscarriage by ultrasound, ectopic pregnancy as well as normal and abnormal variations observed during first trimester will also be discussed.

How it benefits you

Ultrasound is a quick and non-invasive test that is useful in the assessment of a patient's gynaecological complaints and is increasingly becoming an indispensable diagnostic tool in daily clinical applications. Through the lectures, participants will be taught the challenges and complexities of ultrasound diagnosis of gynaecological conditions.

1400hr : The role of ultrasound in deep infiltrating endometriosis (DIE) – Ms Wong Wai Leng

We will demonstrate sonographic diagnosis of endometriomas and extraovarian endometriosis, including rectovaginal endometriosis.

1430hr : Ultrasound Evaluation of Caesarean section scars and impact on subsequent pregnancies – Ms Lee Sook Ling

Incomplete healing of the scar is a recognized sequel of Caesarean section (CS) and may be associated with complications in later pregnancies. We will present an overview of ultrasound-based definitions and methods used to describe CS scars.

1545hr : Ectopic Pregnancy- Ultrasonographic Approach - Dr Lam Shu Lin

The sonographic approach to the diagnosis of ectopic pregnancies will be discussed. The US features of various types of ectopic gestation including less common forms such as scar, interstitial and cervical ectopics will be illustrated with important pointers towards their diagnosis.

Ultrasound examples of mimics, challenges in the diagnosis and unusual pregnancies will be shown.

1615hr : Pregnancy Failure & First Trimester Variations - Dr June Tan

We will present the guidelines in assessing pregnancy failure and medicolegal implications of incorrect diagnoses & discuss the significance of ultrasound variations such as an irregular yolk sac and an eccentric pregnancy.

1645hr : Ultrasound and Ovarian Cancer: Application of IOTA Rules in evaluation of adnexal masses – A/Professor Ong Chiou Li

This lecture will demonstrate diagnosis of different types of ovarian cysts and highlight the application of IOTA in ultrasonographic characterisation of ovarian malignancy.
