✓ Synopsis

Undergoing surgery is not an everyday occurrence for most patients. Although patients have given consent for the surgery, many still feel a sense of helplessness. There will be feelings of fear and also having to cope with pain and an unfamiliar environment. There are however numerous opportunities for healthcare to address some of the touch points such that the experience of the patient is improved. This improved care can also work to reduce adverse events especially in the less cooperative patient.

This workshop is a collaboration between Khoo Teck Puat Hospital Perioperative Services and Humanitude organisation. Humanitude has transformed the way patients, especially the elderly and cognitively impaired are cared for.

The workshop will:

1. Explore the care needs of the perioperative patient
2. Discuss how to heighten care and trust between the patient and the care team
3. Provide specific case-studies to contextualise the principles
4. Provide practical tips and hands-on practice on the techniques described

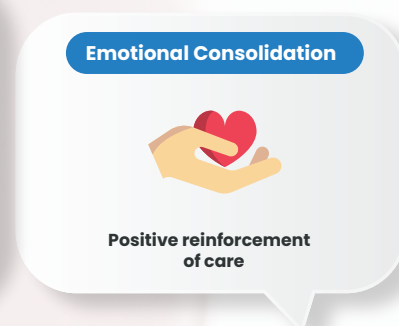
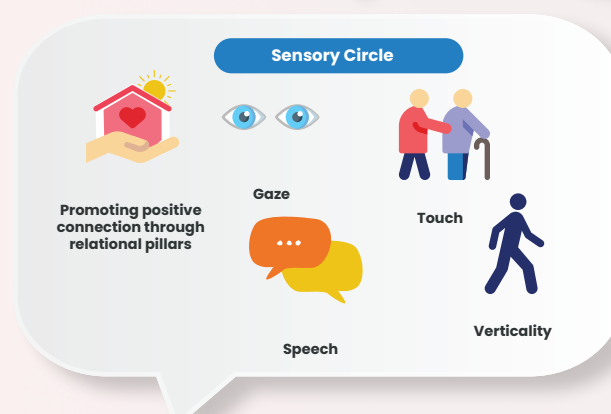
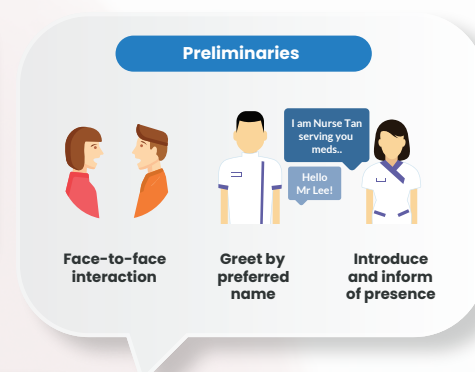
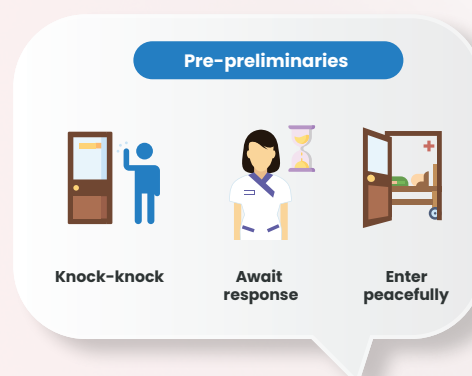
